



# 2019 Emergency Skills Day for Maternity Health Professionals

The Combined Emergency Skills Day comprises updates in **both maternal and newborn resuscitation** as well as midwifery management of childbirth emergencies (e.g. bleeding emergencies, shoulder dystocia, breech and cord prolapse). Attendance at this 8 hour workshop fulfils annual mandatory requirements for both Midwifery Council compulsory education *and* CDHB CPR competency. Annual emergency skills competency can alternatively be achieved through attendance at a PROMPT course
