What?

PROMPT is a one day multi-professional course in teamwork and the management of obstetric emergencies.

Where?

Manawa Level 3, Room 311 & Christchurch Women's Hospital

Who?

Hospital Midwives & LMC's; Obstetric, Anaesthetic, Recovery, ICU & ED staff.

No registration fees.

Why?

- Ministry of Health recommends 'that all staff involved in the care of pregnant women should undertake regular training in management of obstetric emergencies' (PMMRC report).
- Realistic, on-site, teamwork-focused & fun.
- **Midwifery Council** : 8 hrs Continued Education or replaces compulsory Emergency Skills Day (PROMPT contains both Adult & Neonatal resus)
- **RANZCOG**: 8 PD/CPD points in the Clinical Expertise/Meetings category
- **ANZCA CPD**: Emergency response—Major haemorrhage, Knowledge and skills: 12 credits
- 3 yearly attendance maintains essential skills
