This course covers the assessment and stabilisation of sick infants in the post-resuscitation/pre-transport period and is relevant to practitioners in all birthing environments including NICU.

The **S.T.A.B.L.E.** mnemonic assists with retention and recall of stabilisation activities that are critical for care of sick newborn infants:

Sugar and Safe Care

Temperature

Airway

Blood pressure

Lab work

Emotional support
