### What?

PROMPT is a one day multi-professional course in teamwork and the management of obstetric emergencies.

### Where?

Birthing Suite, Christchurch Women's Hospital

### Who?

Hospital midwives & LMC's; Obstetric, Anaesthetic, Recovery, ICU & ED staff.  
No registration fees.

### Why?

- Ministry of Health recommends 'that all staff involved in the care of pregnant women should undertake regular training in management of obstetric emergencies' (PMMRC report).
- Realistic, on-site, teamwork-focused & fun.
- **Midwifery Council** points: 8 hrs Continued Education or replaces compulsory Emergency Skills Day (if attended in addition to a newborn resus refresher)
- **RANZCOG**: 8 PD/CPD points in the Clinical Expertise/Meetings category
- **ANZCA** CPD: Emergency response—Major haemorrhage, Knowledge and skills: 12 credits
- 3 yearly attendance maintains essential skills
