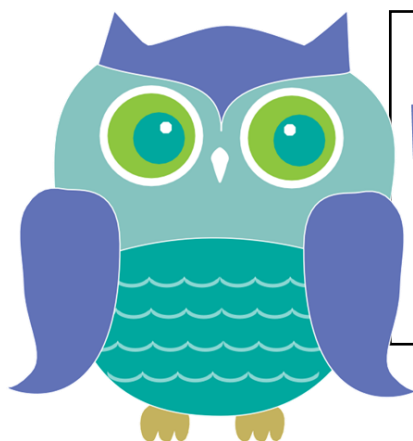

Fetal monitoring training is **mandatory** for all CDHB health professionals undertaking any aspect of EFM, and is a strong recommendation for all self-employed Lead Maternity Carers (LMC's). The CDHB minimum requirements are a once-off face to face session for new staff or for those requiring a more in-depth update. The online OFSEP module is compulsory once every two years for all midwives and time will be reimbursed on presentation of certificate and mark obtained.
