Webinar: The normal CTG and CTG case reviews

Suited to: Graduate midwives, new staff, clinicians who do not look at a lot of CTGs or who have previously found the FSEP assessment difficult.

Details: Briefly covers the normal CTG, excessive uterine activity, maternal heart rate monitoring and an overview of decelerations. The program concludes with a range of CTG based case reviews. Anonymous online polling questions are used to gauge participant understanding and guide the education.

Pre-requisite: OFSEP at a minimum. Ideally participants will have previously attended a face-to-face FSEP session.

Fetal monitoring training is **mandatory** for all CDHB health professionals undertaking any aspect of EFM, and is a strong recommendation for all self-employed Lead Maternity Carers (LMC's). Minimum requirements are a once-off face to face session for CDHB new staff or for those requiring a more in-depth update. The online OFSEP module is compulsory once every two years for all midwives and time will be reimbursed on presentation of certificate and mark obtained. This webinar is approved education for Midwifery Council Recertification Programme
