Remember that the System is case sensitive so you will need to enter CAPITALS where required. On your first login you will be prompted to change this initial password to one of your own choosing.

Accessing the K2 System

You can choose to complete the package from home or from the hospital at your own pace. Go to <http://training.k2ms.com>
Most of the workstations around the CDHB maternity departments are set up for K2 access. Click on Internet Explorer and type the K2 web address in the top address bar or there may be a shortcut on the desktop screen.

Using the Teaching Package

Enjoy your learning through interactive online material at your own pace. Each section of the package will give you an estimate of the time required to complete it. The first two chapters of the Training Package (Acid Base and CTG) will take you between 5 and 8 hours to complete. We recommend that you progress through the chapters sequentially. You can request a certificate to be emailed to you on completion of each section.

There is also a CTG Training Simulator and an Assessment to complete to assess your own knowledge. Extra modules are added at regular intervals, such as the Shoulder Dystocia chapter. If you need to exit at any time during your training, K2 will bookmark your progress so that you will automatically return to the last page you were working on when you next log in.

Keeping up to date

Some form of fetal monitoring training is mandatory **each year** for CDHB midwives and doctors working in maternity care – either online K2 or face to face teaching through the RANZCOG fetal surveillance education programmes (FSEP). You can test your knowledge each year by completing the K2 assessment tool (25 quiz questions) and this will refer you back to the sections in which you need most revision.

Midwifery Council Points

The K2 package has been approved by the Midwifery Council of New Zealand and been allocated five elective points for completion of the first two chapters of the Training Package (Acid Base and CTG) plus an additional five elective points each time you complete 10 of the CTG training simulations plus one attempt at the Assessment Tool.
