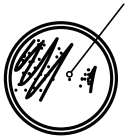

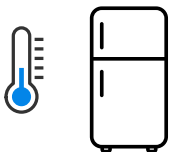

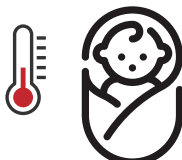

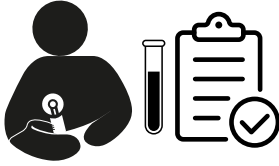

Screened, unpasteurised donor milk

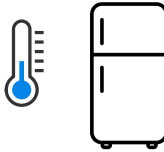

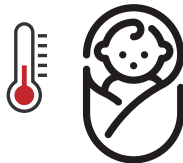
