

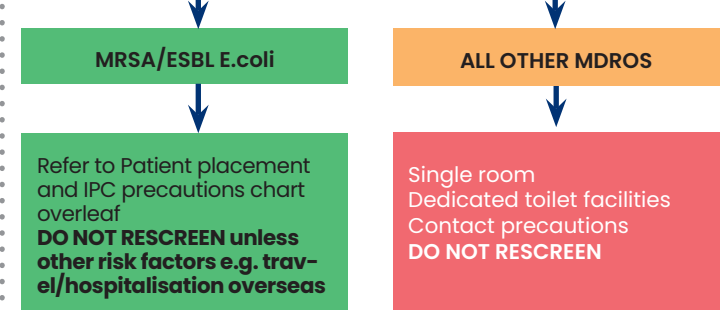

ABBREVIATIONS

- MRSA** – Methicillin Resistant Staphylococcus aureus
- ESBL** – Extended Spectrum Beta Lactamase producing bacteria
- VRE** – Vancomycin Resistant Enterococci
- CPO/CPE** Carbapenemase- Producing Organism/ Carbapenemase- Producing Enterobacterales (CPOs include organisms such as Pseudomonas).
- CRAB** – Carbapenem Resistant Acinetobacter baumannii
- C. auris** – Candida auris

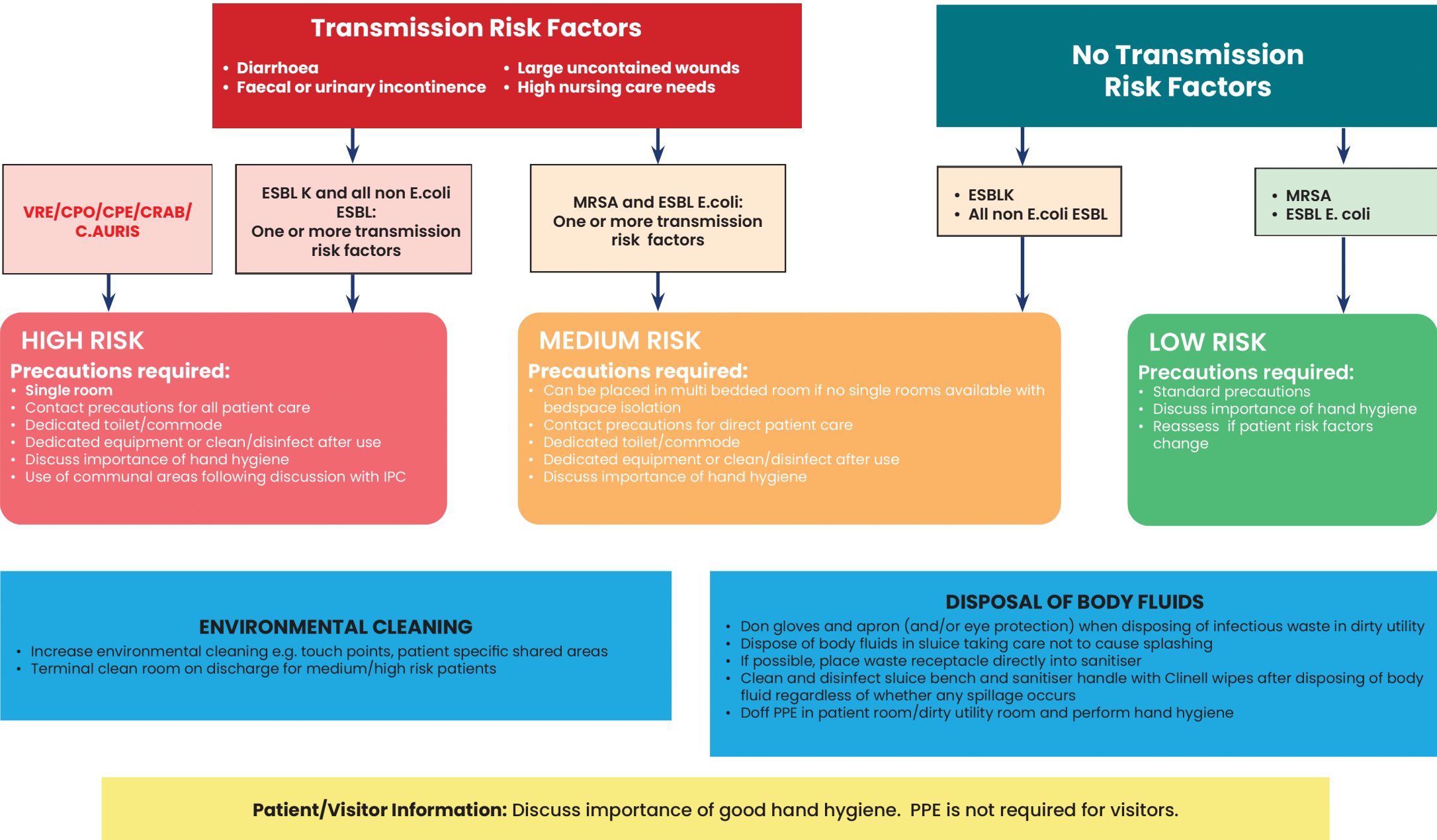
- Endoscopy

TESTING INSTRUCTIONS

- MRSA TESTING** – Purple Top bacterial swabs from nose, groin, perineum. Also from wounds, stoma or catheter (if present). Moisten swab in media prior to taking specimen.
- MDRO FAECAL TESTING** – Purple Top bacterial swabs from rectum with visible **faecal matter present**. Alternatively, a faecal specimen.
